UBCTS Career Pathways

College or Post-Secondary Training

- UBCTS students can earn college credit in their field of study at schools throughout the state.
- Technical Entrepreneurship Associates Degree at Bucks can complete one year of the 2 year degree upon high school graduation

Skilled Employment

- UBCTS students can enter the workforce after graduating as a skilled worker, which translates into more \$\$\$
- Can start your skilled employment while still in high school through Cooperative Education.

• UBCTS students can put their advanced training into action through the armed services

Cooperative Education Program (Co-Op)

Students are able to earn a sustainable wage while receiving on the job training from their mentors at work.

- 11th and 12 grade students
- Attend UBCTS 1-2 days a week, directly to work the other days
- Potential for post-graduation employment

Current Co-Op Students

- Over 70 students currently in Co-Op placements
- UBCTS students are making double the PA minimum wage of \$7.25 while still in high school

- Machining & Engineering Technologies \$18.00 per hour
- Mechatronics \$15.00 per hour
- Electrical Technology \$15.00 per hour
- Non Co-Op Mechatronics \$27.00 per hour
