

Core Courses (4 or 4.5 credits)

- Less Commonly Taught Languages and Cultures: Mandarin or Arabic

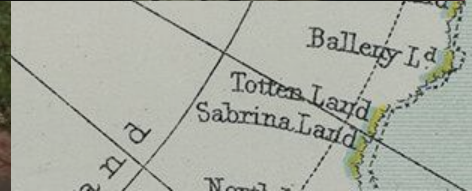
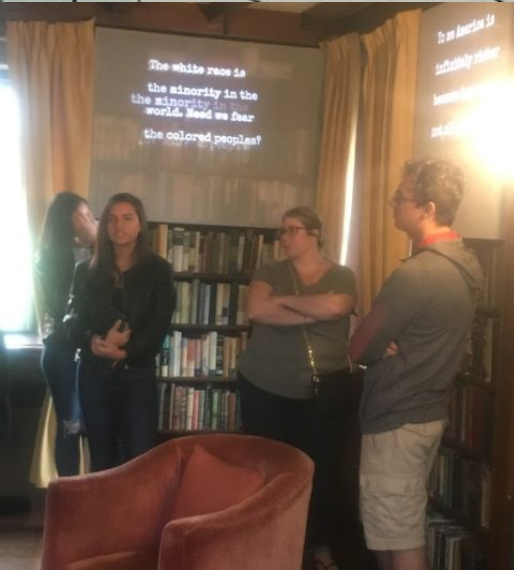
- **School sponsored field trips that explore a global perspective**

- **Attending a lecture or event at a local college regarding a global topic**



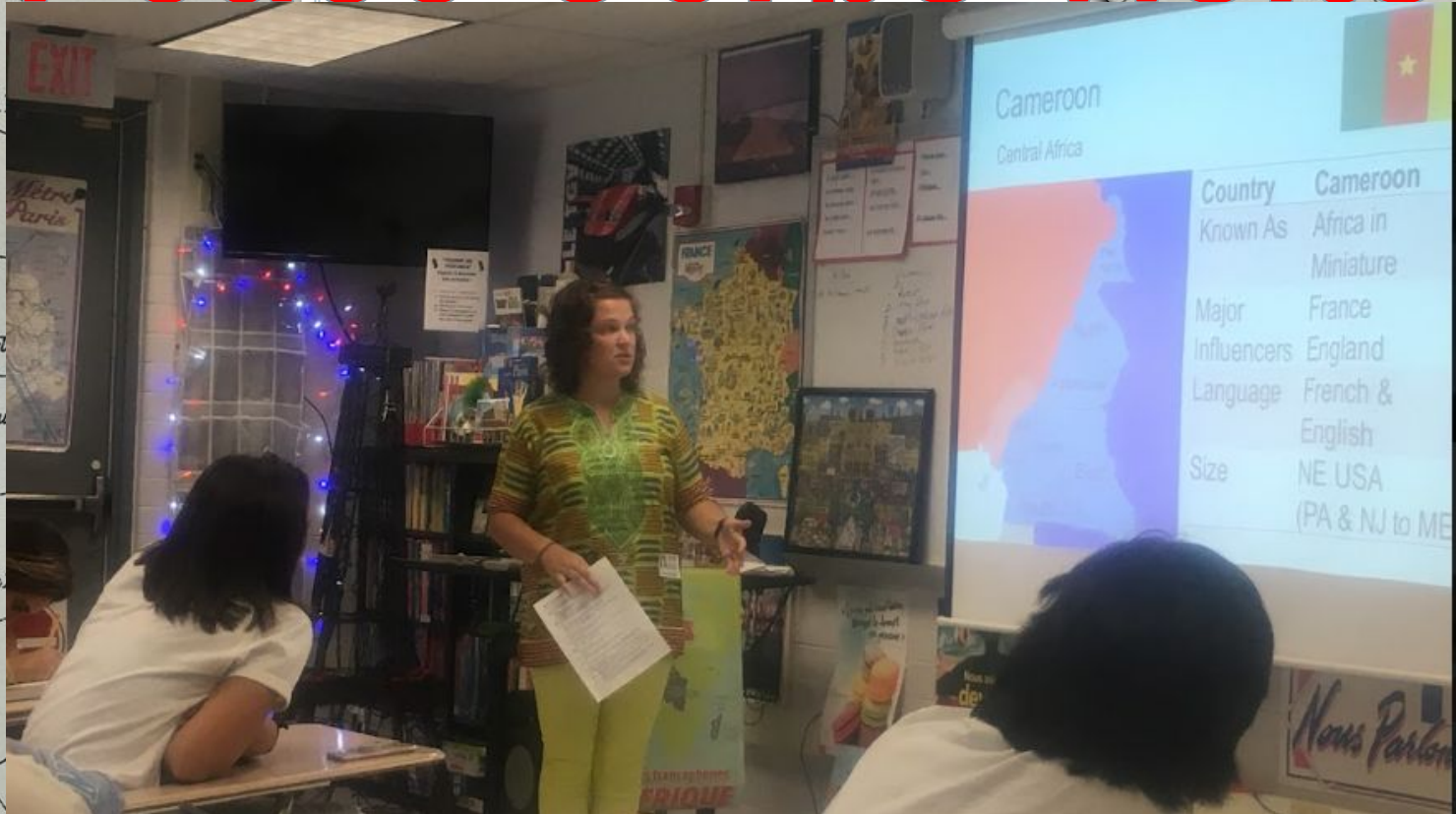

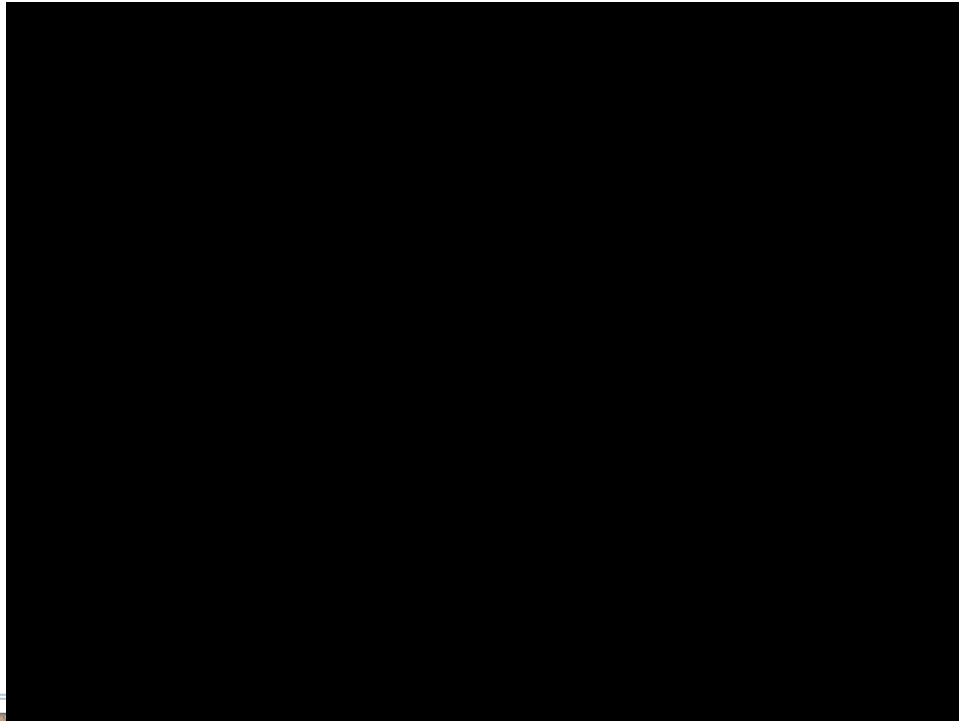
