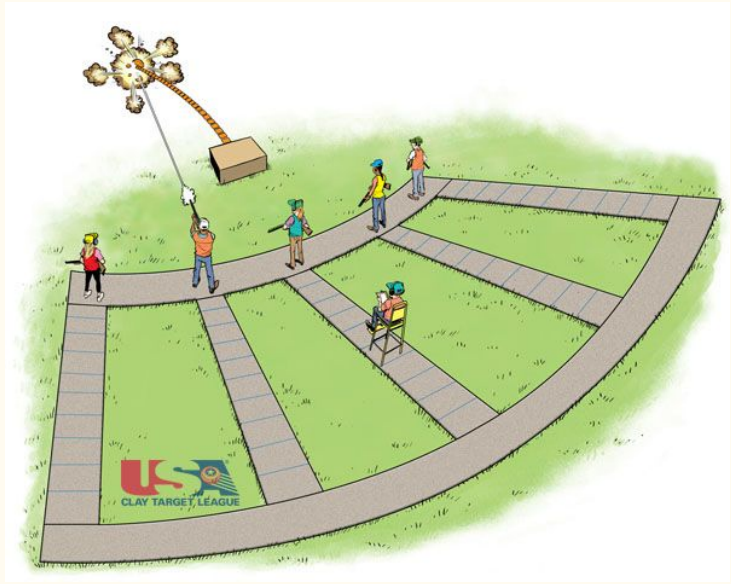

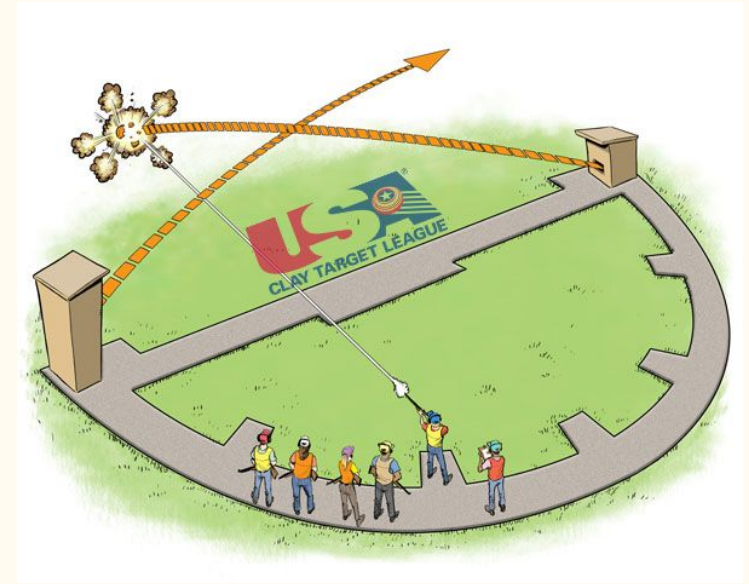

What is needed from participants?

What every student needs to participate:

- 1) Shotgun and appropriate ammo
 - a) No reloads, tracer, etc....
 - i) Roughly 200 rounds of ammo (on paper)
 - b) Game/target loads
 - c) Any caliber that does not exceed 12 gauge, no less than 24 inch barrel.
- 2) Hearing/Eye protection
- 3) Completion of a safety course
 - a) PA Hunting License
 - b) SAFE course
- 4) Transportation of the student and firearm to the range for practices/competitions.



How to join the club:

- 1) Complete a safety course.
- 2) \$35 League entry fee per student.
 - a) This covers the student under their insurance program.
- 3) Show up to practice
- 4) Do not violate rules.

If you need a shotgun, I can bring mine for students to borrow.
